Your typical schedule will be 10:00am - 1:00pm in the pre-season (early summer). and 9:00am - 3:00pm or 5:00pm-10:00pm in full summer season. This is an example schedule and certain schedule cannot be guaranteed.

Position Description:

Participants must appreciate hard work; enjoy working with and for others; take pride in a job well done; and be committed to providing first-class service to guests.

The work is highly customer oriented. Employees must be willing to do various cleaning jobs and must be willing to work on their feet all day.

Food Runners/ Pantry Runners will be responsible for assisting servers in delivering food to guest tables, assisting with packaging takeout orders and other various ingredients such as sauces and condiments, making salads, and performing other various duties as assigned.

At the beginning there will be more cross training, in non-busy times, to facilitate efficient use of time as well as determining the best job for an employee based on their skill.

Participants will be doing prep work and other odd jobs, when not busy, including cooking and washing dishes or other cleaning tasks. There may be other job duties assigned, that are not listed, at the discretion of the manager/supervisor.

The Food Runner/ Pantry Runner staff must be able to spend long hours on their feet in a hot kitchen environment. You will need to be able to communicate with employees to accurately perform your tasks and ask for help if you need it.

We rely on teamwork, and clear communication, so it's extremely important that you are able to work well with others.

You must arrive by the date agreed upon at the interview, and listed on your work offer, and are expected to work until the last day listed on your work offer.

You will be expected to arrive to work on time, every day, and dressed in proper uniform.

Bandanas Mexican Grille has high standards of cleanliness and guest service. You will be expected to make sure you perform your job responsibilities as taught in training and according to company standards.

It is possible for participants to obtain a second job, but the second job must not interfere with the schedule for your job at Bandanas Mexican Grille.

From Manhattan:

You will depart from the Port Authority bus terminal on 41st street and 8th ave. Take a New Jersey Transit Bus to Wildwood. You will have to transfer at the Atlantic City Bus Terminal. * YOU MUST TAKE YOUR LUGGAGE WITH YOU WHEN YOU TRANSFER BUSES*
