Area Information:

The City of Niagara Falls borders a World Famous park (Niagara Falls State Park) affording a close-up view of the American, Horseshoe and Bridal Veil Falls.

The waterfalls are the main attraction here, and there's a range of ways to see them: from their foot on the legendary Maid of the Mist boat tours; from behind in caves accessible by elevator; from the sky hovering in helicopters; or gazing from observation towers. But away from the falls, both the New York and Canadian sides offer various activities to keep visitors entertained.

It is a destination rich in history, culture, outdoor recreation, shopping, adventure and agriculture. From performing arts venues like Lewiston's Artpark to cultural centers including the Castellani Art Museum, the Native American Museum of Art and the Herschell Carrousel Factory Museum, Niagara Falls' area attractions present an impressive vacation agenda.

Discover fascinating historic sites like Old Fort Niagara, where minutes from Niagara Falls, 300 years of history unfurl. The site of historic battles and sieges, trading and conquest, the fort is preserved as it stood in the 1700's, when France and Britain controlled Niagara.

During summer, temperatures can get fairly high and visitors can get away with wearing a t-shirt, shorts and sneakers. Although most of the time the weather is bright and sunny, sporadic rainfall is a possibility. The daily high temperatures in June July and August range from 25° to 21° degrees Celsius.
